#### **Community input sought on High Speed Rail Alternatives Analysis**

MENLO PARK, CA – On Friday, February 19, 2010 members of the Menlo Park community can hear a presentation regarding the Alternatives Analysis for the High Speed Rail project. The meeting is currently scheduled for 2:30 pm in the Menlo Park Council Chambers, located at 701 Laurel Street in Menlo Park. The meeting will include very preliminary information on possible alternatives for how the rail infrastructure in Menlo Park could be designed. The meeting provides an opportunity for community review and input prior to the California High Speed Rail Authority (HSRA) releasing its formal Alternatives Analysis, showing different grade separations through the Peninsula, on March 4.

In addition, the Context Sensitive Solution (CSS) process will be reviewed. CSS will be used to build involvement from community stakeholders the alternatives evaluation process, both for review of the March draft and for subsequent process steps.
