

**NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS  
BID PROPOSALS SOUGHT FOR  
KELLY PARK IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT**

The City of Menlo Park invites qualified contractors to submit sealed bid proposals for the construction of the KELLY PARK IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT. Work required as part of this project consists of, in general, the demolition of the existing restroom, baseball diamond, soccer field, parking lot, field lighting, plantings and the construction of a new synthetic turf field, resilient rubber track, tennis courts, basketball court, parking lot, pre-fabricated restroom/storage building, planting and irrigation at 100 Terminal Avenue in the City of Menlo Park; all as shown on the plans and described in the specifications. Performance of this work requires a valid California Contractor's License Class A. Project documents and copies of the prevailing rate of wages can be obtained from the Menlo Park Engineering Division, located in the Administrative Building at 701 Laurel St. Bidders are required to attend a pre-bid meeting to discuss the project scope of work. The pre bid meeting shall be held at 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, May 12, 2010 at the project site at 100 Terminal Avenue in Menlo Park, CA. Sealed bid proposals will be received at the Engineering Division office until 2 p.m. on Wednesday, May 26, 2010, at which time they will be opened and publicly read.
