The City of Menlo Park invites qualified contractors to submit sealed bid proposals for the construction of the PEDESTRIAN AND BICYCLE IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE SAFE ROUTES TO LAUREL SCHOOL PROJECT. Work required as part of this project consists of, in general, installing electronic speed feedback displays, installing traffic signs, installing traffic striping and markings, constructing asphalt concrete pathways, constructing asphalt concrete dikes, constructing Portland cement concrete valley gutter, sidewalk, and handicapped ramp, installing in-pavement lighted crosswalk systems, installing street lights, and installing pedestrian countdown signal heads; and all appurtenant work in place and ready for use at various locations in the City of Menlo Park; all as shown on the plans and described in the specifications. Performance of this work requires a valid California Contractor's License Class A. The UDBE contract goal for the project is 3.8%. The DBE contract goal for the project is 9.2%. Project documents and copies of the prevailing rate of wages can be obtained from the Menlo Park Transportation Division, located in the Administrative Building at 701 Laurel St. Sealed bid proposals will be received at the Transportation Division office until 2 p.m. on THURSDAY, JULY 15, 2010, at which time they will be opened and publicly read.
