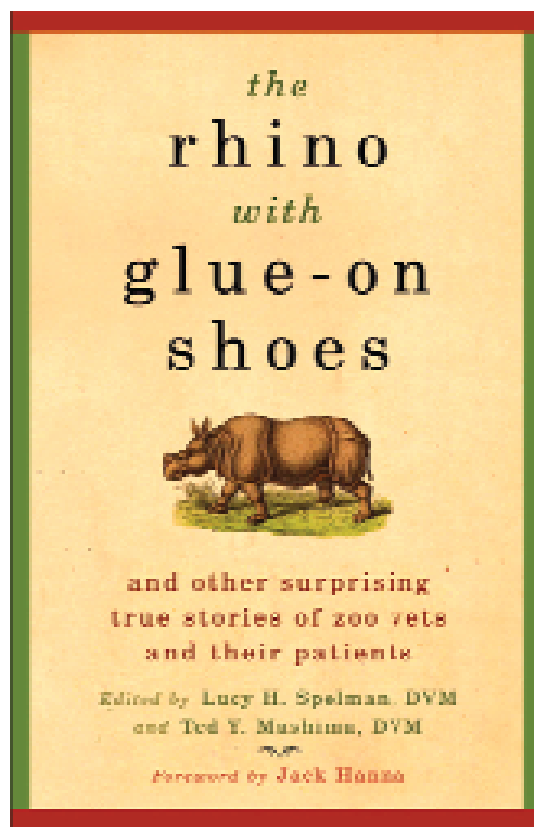

Dr. Lucy H. Spelman, DVM, DACZM, is a veterinarian committed to the study and advancement of health care for wild animals. Her patients include endangered animals in far-flung parts of the globe—giant pandas in China, Asian elephants in Burma, giant river otters in Guyana, and (currently) mountain gorillas in Rwanda. She currently works for a non-profit conservation organization, the Mountain Gorilla Veterinary Project, as its Africa-based regional manager. Dr. Spelman is a former director of the Smithsonian Institution's National Zoo and has also worked as a scientific advisor for Discovery Communications. In July 2008, she published, "The Rhino with Glue-on Shoes," a collection of true stories by zoo and wildlife veterinarians about their wild animal patients, co-edited with Dr. Ted Mashima. She also contributed the story that gives the book its title, about a rhino with sore feet.
