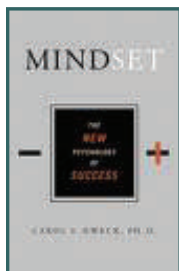

### **MINDSET: How Praise Can Foster or Undermine Children's Achievement**

MINDSET is a simple idea formulated by world-renowned Stanford University psychologist Carol Dweck in decades of research on achievement and success—a simple idea that makes all the difference. Teaching a *growth* mindset creates motivation and productivity.

Every word and action sends a message. It can be a fixed mindset message that says, "You have permanent traits and I'm judging them." Or it can be a growth mindset message that says, "You are a developing person and I am interested in your development."

In this presentation, Dr. Dweck will teach parents how to use both praise and criticism well. She'll discuss why bright children sometimes stop working and what to do about it, and parents will learn how to communicate values that bring success.
