



NEIGHBORHOOD MEETING

Regarding a Project at 1706 El Camino Real (formerly Gaylords Restaurant)

The preparation of a transportation impact analysis is required for the proposed 10,166-square foot medical/dental building. A traffic study is in the process of being finalized by DKS Associates.

The City would like to invite you to a neighborhood meeting to share the preliminary traffic study results, which identified two potential traffic impacts at the intersections of:

- 1) Buckthorn Way and El Camino Real during the weekday AM Peak (7-9 a.m.) and PM Peak (4-6 p.m.) hours, and
- 2) Spruce Avenue and El Camino Real during the weekday PM Peak (4-6 p.m.) hours.

Staff will also review potential options to address the impacts, including left turn restrictions from Buckthorn Way and Spruce Avenue onto El Camino Real during the morning and/or afternoon peak hours. The meeting will be facilitated by a neutral agency to ensure that all comments are heard. City staff as well as the applicant will be at the meeting to listen to the comments and to discuss the alternatives.

This is an opportunity to learn more, to share your ideas, and provide comments on the project. Your continued participation is both welcomed and needed throughout this process!
