

YMCA approved provider

EDP is now considered a YMCA approved provider. This means that families can apply for financial assistance through YMCA and if you qualify payments for childcare will be paid by YMCA directly to SDCCS. This will take some of the financial burden off of our school and our families. There is a chart below that gives the financial requirements that qualify a family for the assistance. If you qualify we are asking that you please apply for this aid for your children and our school. Thank you!

Subsidy for EDP

YMCA offers subsidy, which is assistance in paying childcare. EDP is an approved provider. The application process is simple. You can go online to childcaresandiego.com or the application is attached to this email. This will help out our school financially by allowing the funds from the state to help off set the expense of the program. Please check the eligibility table below and if you qualify, please apply! Even if you are already receiving subsidy through the school, we ask that you still apply for this program so that the school will no longer be off- setting the costs.

How can I qualify for CEL?

Qualifying for CEL is based on gross monthly income (before taxes), family size, and need. In addition, families must work, live or attend school in San Diego County to qualify. In order to be considered income-eligible, families must meet State Income Requirements and have at least one of the following needs for child care:

- (a) Working
- (b) Looking for work
- (c) Medically incapacitated
- (d) Attending school or in training
- (e) Receiving Child Protective Services (CPS)
- (f) Part-day educational preschool
- (g) Seeking permanent housing
