The City of Burnsville, through its emergency preparedness efforts, is offering neighborhood training and assistance in preparing for such events through the Community Emergency Response Team or “CERT” program. Training areas such as **disaster preparedness, disaster firefighting, basic medical operations, light search and rescue, disaster psychology and team organization** all culminate with a simulation exercise to enhance your training experience.

DATES/TIME: Tuesday and Thursday evenings, from April 21 through May 19, 2009. Training will be held from 6:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. (You must attend both sessions each week)

COST: \$15.00
