

Project Green Tree Sale set for Saturday, April 26 2003

The City of Burnsville has 500 trees ready for sale at the annual Project Green Tree Sale set for Saturday, April 26 at the former Maintenance Facility located at 75 Civic Center Parkway across the street from City Hall. The sale starts promptly at 8:00 a.m. and continues until 12:00 Noon, or until all trees are sold. Quantities are limited and each household may select 2 trees. **The Tree Sale is for Burnsville residents only and identification will be checked.**

The Forestry Department recommends that homeowners prepare a place in their yard where the tree will be planted before coming to the sale. Keep in mind that trees are not allowed to be planted along the boulevard-15 feet from the curb. Since the trees are provided bare root they must be planted immediately. The trees are locally grown and vary in size from 6-12 feet high.

When: Saturday, April 26 8:00 a.m. until Noon, or until all trees are purchased

Where: Former Maintenance Facility - 75 Civic Center Parkway, near City Hall

Seventeen total varieties offered including:

Autumn Ash, Bergeson Ash, Fallgold Ash, Patmore Ash, River Birch, Whitespire Birch, American Sentry Linden, Royal Red Maple, Autumn Blaze Maple, Rubrum Maple, Silver Blair Maple, Sugar Green Maple, Mountain Ash Blackhawk, Pin Oak, Swamp Oak, Quaking Aspen.
