## **BURNSVILLE CITY COUNCIL NAMES CITY MANAGER FINALISTS**

The Burnsville City Council named four finalists for City Manager after a meeting held Tuesday evening at Burnsville City Hall. The search attracted 22 total applicants and the list was narrowed to 10 applicants prior to the meeting. The process for naming a new City Manager is on schedule, with interviews set for March 14 and 15. The City Council is scheduled to discuss the candidates on Monday, March 17. A decision is anticipated by the end of March.

The four finalists include, *presented in alphabetical order*,

- **Craig Ebeling**, Director of Development and Redevelopment, City of Burnsville.
- **Ronald Moore**, City Administrator, City of Orono, Minnesota.
- **Steve O'Malley**, Deputy City Manager/Chief Financial Officer, City of Burnsville.
- **Dave Pokorney**, City Manager, City of Chaska, Minnesota.

The City of Burnsville (population 60,220) is Minnesota's 10<sup>th</sup> largest city and operates under the Plan B form of city government. By law, the City Manager is the lone employee of the City Council. Through the City's governance model, the manager is responsible for the implementation of policy set by the council. The position became available in December when former City Manager Greg Konat accepted a position with Dakota County as Director of the Physical Development Division. Tom Hansen, Deputy City Manager, has been serving as Acting City Manager until a permanent replacement is named.
