Volunteers needed for Terrace Oaks Ski Chalet

The City of Burnsville is recruiting volunteers to serve as a Cross County Ski Attendant at Terrace Oaks Park for the upcoming winter season. The position is headquartered out of the chalet which is located just east of County Road 11 and south of Burnsville Parkway. The position involves care for the chalet and the surrounding park areas, managing the ski concession and equipment rental, and ensuring skier safety.

The Terrace Oaks Chalet is open Monday-Friday from 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. and Weekends from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. The season runs from December 15 to March 15. The chalet may also open during weekday hours if volunteers are available to assist. Volunteers are needed to fill any or all of the above times.

Qualified volunteers must be at least 18 years of age, have the ability to work independently and interact with the public in a positive manner, maintaining good public relations.

The City of Burnsville involves community members with service opportunities through an active volunteer program. Over 1000 residents are involved with volunteering with the City each year in projects ranging from once a year Adopt-A-Street projects to part-time regular police department records assistants.
