CITY COUNCIL SEEKS YOUTH MEMBERS FOR ADVISORY BOARDS

The Burnsville City Council is seeking applications from high school juniors or sophomores who are interested in membership on the Parks and Natural Resources Commission or the Lake Alimagnet Center for the Arts Board. These commissions are charged with the responsibility of researching, reviewing, and making recommendations on related issues and serve as advisory bodies to the City Council.

Parks and Natural Resources Commission (PNRC)

Serves as an advisory body, which makes recommendations on issues, related to park, recreation, and open space needs of the community and protection of Burnsville's natural resources.

Lake Alimagnet Center for the Arts (LACA)

Promotes, facilitates, and helps determine the needs of cultural arts groups in the Burnsville area, as well as advising the City on the management and coordination of the use of the Lake Alimagnet Center for the Arts.

(One regular youth-junior/sophomore)

All terms will be for one year with membership open to any Burnsville resident who is a high school junior or sophomore. Positions will be appointed by the City Council.
