## **FREE HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE DROP-OFF DAY SET FOR SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 24**

*Event held at City's Maintenance Center from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.*

Looking to get rid of some old paint? The City of Burnsville is hosting a Household Hazardous Waste Collection on Saturday, September 24 from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. at the City of Burnsville Maintenance Facility, 13713 Frontier Court.

Most items will be collected free of charge and the collection is open to Dakota County residents. A Driver's License listing a Dakota County address will be required. No business waste will be accepted. The Household Hazardous Waste Collection is funded by the City of Burnsville in partnership with the Dakota County Board of Commissioners.

The City of Burnsville holds two collection days per year and coordinates recycling activities cooperatively with Eagan and Apple Valley through Dakota Valley Recycling. In addition to the Fall Household Hazardous Waste Drop-off Day, an Appliance Drop Off Day is conducted in the spring. Appliances -\$10: Washer/Dryers, Water Heaters, Garbage Disposals, Trash Compactors, Ranges/Stoves, Refrigerators/Freezers, Furnaces, Microwaves, Dehumidifiers, Dishwashers, and Heat Pumps

Air Conditioners - \$20

Televisions and computers - \$25 for large TV's and monitors, \$15 for regular size TV' and monitors

Electronic Equipment - \$3

Tires - \$2 and up
