STATE PRIMARY ELECTION, September 12, 2006

The City of Burnsville will have polling locations for 17 precincts open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. for the State Primary Election, Tuesday, September 12, 2006. You must vote at the polling place for the precinct where your current residence is located. Additional information is available on the Internet at www.burnsville.org or by calling Burnsville City Hall at 952-895-4400.

Voter Registration

Voter pre-registration for the State Primary Election is open through August 22 at 5:00 p.m. Although registration on Election Day can be accomplished by providing the proper proof of residence, get registered ahead of time and save yourself delay at the polling place. Absentee Ballot Voting

Absentee Ballots for the State Primary Election, Tuesday, September 12 will be available from Friday, August 11 through September 11 until 5:00 p.m.

The criteria for absentee voting are:

- absent from your precinct on election day
- ill or disabled
- prevented from going to the polling place because of religious discipline or religious holiday.
- an election judge serving in another precinct

You can obtain your absentee ballot in person at City Hall, 100 Civic Center Parkway during normal business hours, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday and the Monday prior to Election Day until 5:00 p.m. Absentee voting will also be open on Saturday September 9 from 10:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.

If you would like to vote absentee by mail, apply early so you can mail or deliver your absentee ballot back before Election Day. Call the Election Hot Line (952) 895-4433 after August 11 or 952-895-4400 to have an application mailed to you.
