GENERAL ELECTION, NOVEMBER 7, 2006

The City of Burnsville will have polling locations for 17 precincts open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. for the General Election, Tuesday, November 7. You must vote at the polling place for the precinct where your current residence is located. Additional information is available on the Internet at www.burnsville.org or by calling the City Clerk at 952-895-4460.

Voter Registration

Voter pre-registration for the General Election is open through October 17, 2006. Although registration on Election Day can be accomplished by providing the proper proof of residence, get registered ahead of time and save yourself delay at the polling place. Absentee Ballot Voting

Absentee Ballots for the General Election, Tuesday, November 7 will be available at City Hall from October 6 through November 6, 2006.

The criteria for absentee voting are:

- absent from your precinct on election day
- ill or disabled
- prevented from going to the polling place because of religious discipline or religious holiday.
- an election judge serving in another precinct

You can obtain your absentee ballot in person from City Hall, 100 Civic Center Parkway during normal business hours, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. Absentee voting will also be open on Saturday, November 4 from 10:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. and on Monday, November 6 until 5:00 p.m.

If you would like to vote absentee by mail, apply early so you can mail or deliver your absentee ballot back before Election Day. Call the Election Hot Line (952) 895-4433 to have an application mailed to you. Your request/application must include your Burnsville address, where you want the ballot sent, and your legal signature.

Municipal Election
