Do you want to try something new with your home but don't know where to turn? The City of Burnsville's Home Remodeling Advisor Program may be able to help. Answers to questions about adding a deck or putting on a new addition or replacing windows, and more are now available, free of charge for Burnsville homeowners.

The Home Remodeling Advisor Program matches an experienced, unbiased remodeling advisor directly with a homeowner to discuss remodeling ideas. The advisor will come directly to the home for a free two-hour consultation. Homeowners are able to ask about any remodeling idea – either interior or exterior – and the advisor will assist in the decision making process. The program is intended to provide unbiased information and not sell the homeowner on any particular direction or product.

The City of Burnsville is partnering with the Center for Energy and the Environment (CEE) and the Dakota County Community Development Agency (CDA) for the program. CEE is a leading non-profit organization that promotes the responsible use of natural and economic resources. The CDA is the county's housing agency that works with cities to provide programs to help revitalize their communities. The program is part of the City of Burnsville's continuing program to maintain and improve neighborhood viability.
