**Burnsville Ice Center – 2010 Improvements**

In general, work consist of: demolition of existing concrete ice rink floors, refrigeration system, mechanical and building systems, building management systems, lighting; and construction of a new concrete ice rink floors, waste heat recovery systems, snow melt pit, dehumidification systems, geothermal system with vertical wells, mechanical systems, building addition, and site work. Work Includes: Demolition, excavation, grading, backfilling, concrete, refrigeration, HVAC systems, geothermal well field construction, interior and exterior piping, roofing, walls, painting, electrical, controls, site restoration and related items.

The estimated construction cost for this Project is \$4,700,000

A Pre-Bid Meeting will be held at 11:00 a.m. at the Burnsville Ice Center on Monday, November 30, 2009.

This project is partially funded by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA), special requirements apply.
