Stearns County Sheriff: Burglary and Theft

On 1/19/07, SCSO received a report of a break in to a storage shed on 234th St in Rockville . Unknown persons had forced entry to the shed and stole a Snap-On tool chest full of tools. Tools stolen were hand and power tools of various makes including Snap-On, Matco, Craftsman, and Maac. Estimated loss is \$2000.00.

Stearns County Sheriff: Residential Burglary and Vandalism

On 1/23/07, SCSO was called to a private home in Pleasant Acres housing addition in St. Wendel Twp. During the daylight hours, unknown persons entered a private home through an unlocked door. Once inside the vandalized the home, nothing was stolen, but the vandals used glue to glue the refrigerator door shut and glue down the toilet seats.
