## St. Cloud Police: Burglary

On 10/13/09 at approximately 1630 hours officers were dispatched to the 1500 block of Germain Street East, in reference to a burglary complaint. The victim, a 19 year old St. Cloud resident, reported that an unknown suspect had entered his apartment and stole \$350 in cash and coin and also a credit card. The victim stated that he was sleeping in his bed during this incident.

## St. Cloud Police: Burglary – Occupied Residence

On 10/11/09 at approximately 0432 hours officers were dispatched to the 500 block of 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue S, St. Cloud, for a theft complaint. Upon arrival officers made contact with the victims who stated that between 2300 hours on 10/10/09 and 0030 hours on 10/11/09 an unknown suspect(s) entered the residence without permission through an unlocked door and ultimately stole numerous items from inside.

Taken from the residence were numerous textbooks, musical equipment, and electronics. The residence was occupied at the time of the burglary.

### **St. Cloud Police: Aggravated Assault with Injuries**

On 09/27/09 at approximately 0224 hours officers were dispatched to the 600 block of 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue North, for a medical.

Investigation revealed that the victim, a 51 year old resident of St. Cloud, appeared to have been assaulted. The victim was transported by Gold Cross Ambulance to the St. Cloud Hospital for life threatening injuries.
