### **St. Cloud Police: Property Damage Complaint**

On 03/29/2010 at approximately 2130 hours, officers from the St. Cloud Police Department were dispatched to the 2400 block of 14<sup>th</sup> Street S for a property damage complaint. Investigation revealed that numerous items throughout the neighborhood had been spray painted.

Some of the items had been spray painted with racial slurs or anti-semitic symbols. The damage is believed to have taken place in the overnight hours between 03/28/10 and 03/29/10. Due to the number of incidents and variety of locations, it does not appear that any one person was targeted.

### **St. Cloud Police: Residential Burglary and Theft**

St. Cloud police are looking for information about a burglary reported early today. Officers were called at 1:30 a.m. to a home in the 600 block of Fifth Street South. Someone entered a home through an unlocked window and stole several items, according to police. No one was home at the time of the incident and no one was injured.

### **St. Cloud Police: Attempted Robbery**

On 3/27/2010 at 0321 hours officers responded to an attempted robbery that occurred in the 2600 block of 5<sup>th</sup> Street North. Through investigation officers learned three unknown black males approached the victim. One of the suspects demanded money from the victim and later attempted to take the victim's backpack.

The victim sustained minor injuries during the incident. The victim was able to escape from the suspects without losing any of his property.

One of the suspects was described as a black male 6' 4", 200 lbs, dark shirt, dark workout pants, no facial hair, no glasses. The other two black males were described as average height, approximately 5' 8" medium builds and wearing lighter colored shirts.

### **St. Cloud Police: Sexual Assault**

St. Cloud police are looking for anyone who might have information on a sexual assault that occurred early Saturday.

Police say a woman was assaulted between 6 a.m. and 7 a.m. in an alley of the 500 block between Sixth and Seventh avenues south. The woman told police she was knocked to the ground and assaulted by a man whom she did not know.

Police learned about the assault during a call to the Women's Center at St. Cloud State University at about 1:20 p.m. today.

## St. Cloud Police: Armed Robbery – Subject considered Dangerous (From week of 3-15-2010)



On 03/18/10 at 0853 hours officers were dispatched to 423 East St. Germain, the Ace Bar & Grill, regarding an armed robbery.

Investigation revealed a business employee had been opening the establishment when he was approached by a masked gunman. The suspect displayed a handgun and obtained an undisclosed amount of cash from the employee.

The suspect is described as a white male, approximately 5'6" to 5'8", with a medium build. The mask is described as being a ski mask-type, having only eye holes and being dark in color. The suspect was wearing dark pants and a lighter blue-colored jacket with white trim near the zipper area. The under side of the jacket sleeves were also a lighter color blue or green. The suspect was wearing white tennis shoes. The suspect left the business in an unknown direction of travel.

Police believe the suspect either works or lives in the area. Any tipsters are asked to call SCPD at 251-1200 or Crime Stoppers at 255-1301. **No one should attempt to confront this guy as he should be considered armed and dangerous**

## Waite Park Police: Robbery and Assault (From week of 3-15-10)

On 3-13-2010 at 316 hrs officers responded to a robbery complaint that occurred on the sidewalk in the 400 block of 7th Street S, Waite Park. The victim was walking when he noticed two the suspects walking toward him. As the victim passed, the males turned around and one male approached the victim and began speaking to him. The victim was then punched numerous times and the suspects attempted to throw the victim to the ground and steal his property.

The victim sustained minor injuries, but was able to get away and call 911. Taken from the victim was a Samsung Rant cell phone, a blue backpack, phone and iPod chargers, a black hooded sweatshirt, and other miscellaneous items.

The suspects are described as two black males approximately 20 years old. One male was wearing a black jacket and the other was wearing a white or light colored hooded sweatshirt. Both males had their hoods over their heads.
