



PHALEN REGIONAL PARK

Saint Paul Parks & Recreation

HISTORY

The City acquired the land in 1899 at a cost of \$22,000. The park was opened to the public soon after. The park named after early settler Edward Phelan whose last name was variously spelled. Phelan staked one of the first claims to the land around Phalen Creek.

PHALEN LAKE

- **Trails** - 3.2 miles around the lake (5K)
- **Fishing** - The Department of Natural Resources reports excellent walleye and northern pike fishing in the deeper sections of Phalen Lake. Bass are sometimes caught in the shallower areas of the lake.
- **Boats/trailers** - Only electric trolling motors are allowed on City lakes. Only cartop carried boats are allowed on the lake. No boat trailers are allowed in Phalen parking lots. Boats may be launched from an authorized boat launch only. Trailer parking is available at the boat launch lot.

PHALEN BEACH

1400 Phalen Drive. Open Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day. Features beach house with concessions and two sand volleyball courts.

- **Swimmers** - Please stay in the designated swim area. **Swimming across the lake is prohibited and violators are subject to ticketing. No pets allowed in beach area.**

PHALEN GOLF COURSE (651) 778-0424

1615 Phalen Drive. A par 70, 6100 yard course, with a driving range, Phalen 18-hole stretches along the west side of Phalen Lake and picnic grounds. Besides carrying the latest in golfing accessories and concessions, the clubhouse is a popular spot for meetings and receptions. The banquet room holds up to 250 people.

The golf season normally runs from April through October, but may be extended if weather permits.

In the winter, Phalen Golf Course provides 10K of groomed intermediate level cross country ski trails, instruction, equipment rental and concessions. Cross country ski trails open December through mid-February, call (651)266-6445 for further information.

PHALEN RECREATION CENTER

1000 E. Wheelock Parkway. This recreation center features a small gym, a kitchen, a game room, a tot lot, and baseball and softball fields. An ice rink is available in the winter. This facility may be rented for parties or receptions.

PHALEN PICNIC PAVILION

1600 Phalen Drive. The picnic pavilion features outside grills, two kitchens with hot water, coolers, and electric stoves and a play area nearby.

PHALEN PICNIC SHELTER

The domed shelter is located on the island with grills and drinking fountain nearby. No electricity

PICNIC INFORMATION

Applications must be made at least seven days in advance of the event. The applications are available at the Central Service Facility, located at 1100 N. Hamline Avenue at the corner of Jessamine. Call (651)632-5111 for information on fees and availability.

AMPHITHEATER

Located next to the picnic pavilion, the Phalen amphitheater is home to a number of summer musical and theatrical events. Call (651)266-6400 for a complete schedule. The amphitheater can also be rented. Call (651)632-5111 for information.

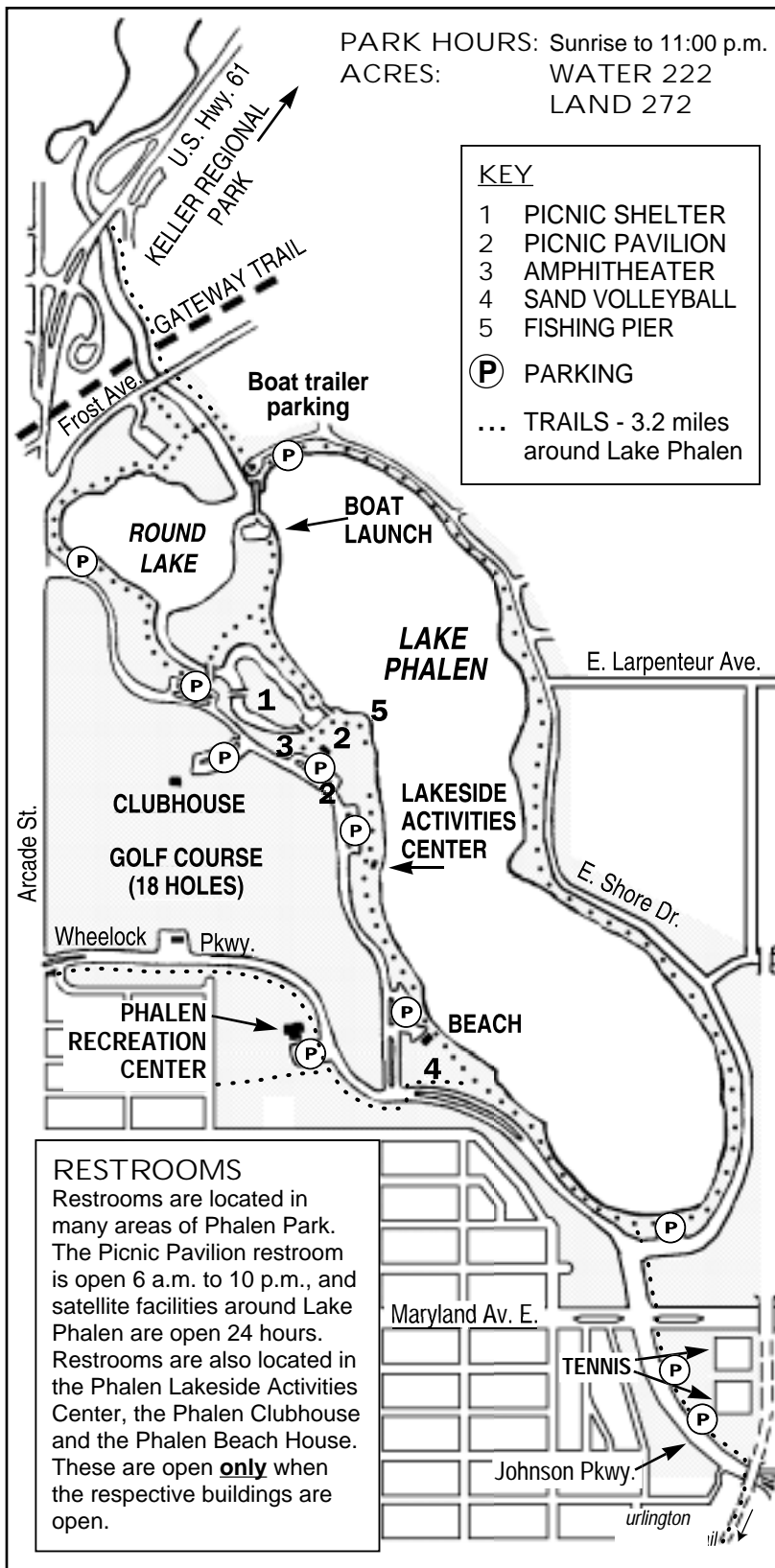

PARK RULES

- **Alcohol** - Nothing stronger than 3.2 beer is permitted in the Phalen Park picnic grounds and no alcohol is allowed after 8:00 p.m. Alcohol is prohibited in all other areas of the park.
- **Dogs** - Owners must secure their pets with a leash six feet long or less while on park property. Owners are required to carry clean-up materials for their pets' droppings. People violating this are subject to ticketing.
- **Fires/grills** - Barbecue grills are available and people may bring their own grill for outdoor cooking. Recreational fires are allowed only at fire rings.
- **Parking** - Parking lots are for visitors using park facilities only. We ask that those using the lots progress immediately to a greenspace area. Loitering in the lots is prohibited.
- **Rollerskates/Inline skates/Skateboards/ Bikes** - may be used only on designated bike paths. Motorized vehicles have the right of way at all intersections with bike paths. Bicyclists are allowed only on bike paths and roads reserved for vehicular traffic.
