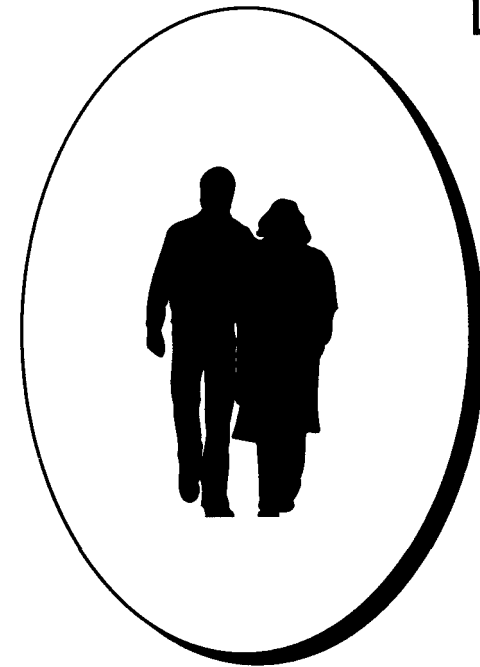

Clark County Community Services provides outpatient services including psychological/psychiatric evaluations, psychological testing, substance abuse counseling, medication management as well as family, group, marital and individual therapy. Services are provided in sessions by appointment with professional clinic staff including clinical therapists, substance abuse counselors, psychologists or psychiatrists. The staff person you meet with will depend upon your specific situation and your individual needs.

Confidentiality

Your attendance at therapy/counseling sessions is held in the strictest confidence bound by the state and federal law. The content of your therapy sessions is between you and the therapist. Information concerning therapy is kept in a confidential file and is reviewed only to the extent necessary with other clinic staff for purposes of case supervision. No one outside of the department will be informed of your contact with this office without your written permission, except where court ordered services are concerned, where information concerning child abuse/neglect is revealed, where there is a duty to warn, or where other exceptions are provided by law. Feel free to ask more about this.

Cost of Services

Most major health insurance companies and medical assistance provide coverage for the services received here. If your particular insurance does not cover, or if you have no health insurance, the cost to you will be based on your ability to pay. The Patient Accounts Specialist will assist you in arriving at the actual cost, if you have no insurance.

Appointments

Please keep appointments that you make. If you are unable to keep a scheduled appointment, cancel the appointment at least 24 hours in advance in order to avoid being charged. Missed appointments, unless canceled 24 hours in advance, will be charged to you.

Discrimination

The Civil Rights Act of 1964 prohibits discriminatory practices in the provision of services by programs receiving federal funds regardless of dollar amounts. In accordance with the Civil Rights Act, no one will be denied services based on race, color, national origin or on previous admissions.

Office Location and Hours

Services are available from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. If circumstances require appointments after 5:00 p.m. this may be arranged. Services are available at the Courthouse office in Neillsville, and at the branch office located at the Clark County Health Care Center, Owen.
